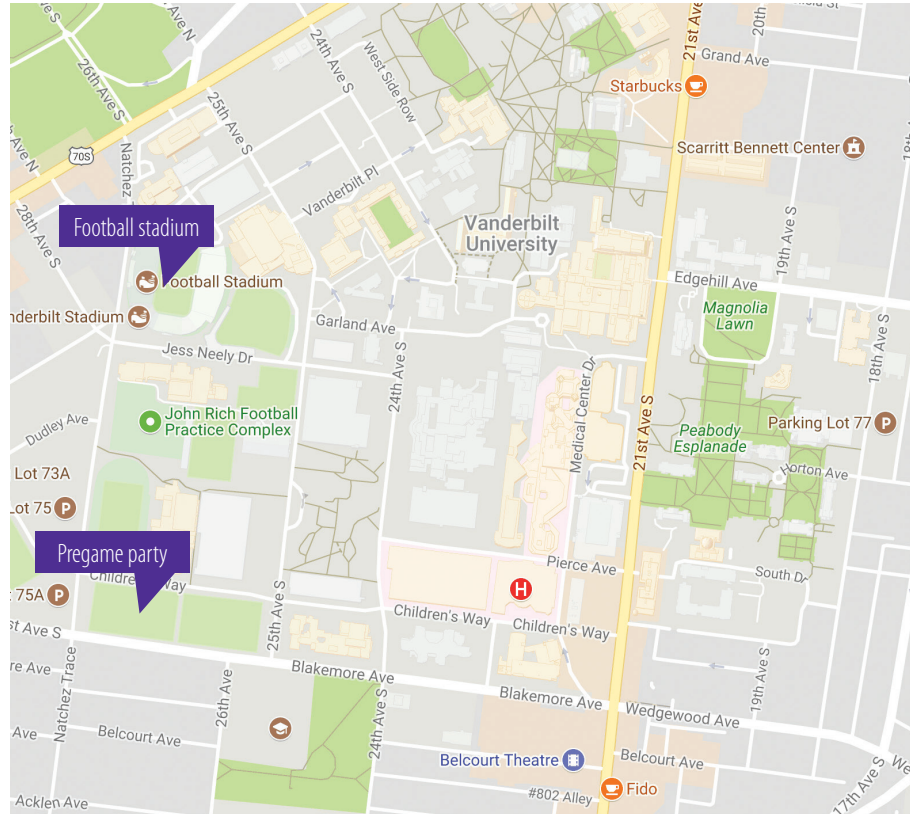

Terrace Place and Wesley Place Garages | FREE

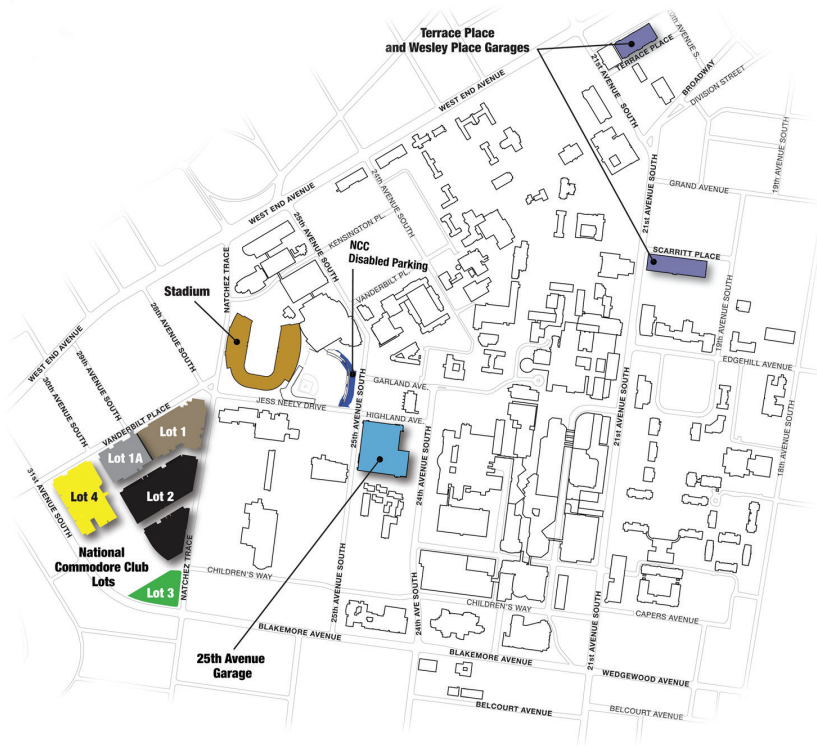

Additional Parking

Fans can park for \$15 per game in 25th Avenue Garage, located at the corner of 25th Avenue and Jess Neely Drive, and the West Garage, located at the corner of 25th Avenue and Children's Way. The garages have handicap parking with elevator access on all floors.

RV Parking

The Nashville Fairgrounds offers RV parking. Parking is \$35 per night and no reservations are required. Please call 615-862-8980 for more information. No RV parking is available on campus.

TRANSPORTATION

Getting to Vanderbilt from Nashville International Airport

Take I-40 west to exit 209A. Turn left onto Broadway. Follow Broadway and veer right to West End Avenue. Allow approximately 30 minutes driving time from the airport to Vanderbilt University. If traffic is light, it will take less time.

Getting to Vanderbilt via the Interstates

From the north, take I-65 to I-40 west and then look for I-40 east to exit 209B. Turn right on Broadway.

From the east or south, take I-40 west to exit 209A. Turn left on Broadway.

From the west, take I-40 east to exit 209B. Turn right on Broadway (US 70S). Follow Broadway and veer right to West End Avenue.

VANDERBILT STADIUM

Due to an increase in security at all public venues and in compliance with the Southeastern Conference, Vanderbilt Stadium has a clear bag policy for all home football games. In order to prevent the inconvenience of returning prohibited items to your vehicle, we encourage you to consider this policy when choosing the items that you bring into the stadium.

Approved Bags

- Clear plastic, vinyl or PVC bags that do not exceed 12" x 6" x 12"
- One-gallon, clear, re-sealable plastic storage bag
- Small clutch bags no larger than 4.5" x 6.5" with or without a handle or strap
- Medically necessary items (after inspection at designated location)

Prohibited Bags Include (but are not limited to):

purses, backpacks, diaper bags, mesh bags, tinted bags, printed pattern plastic bags, cinch/drawstring bags, briefcases, coolers, fanny packs, luggage of any kind, computer bags, camera bags, binocular cases, personal seatbacks, any bag larger than permissible size

STADIUM POLICIES

Gates

Vanderbilt Stadium gates open two hours before kickoff.

You may enter the stadium through any gate, but for the quickest access to your seat, please enter at the appropriate gate.

Gate 1 - Sections A-D, Media

Gate 2 - Sections E-K, Family Zone, Suite Level

TV Service Gate - Credentialed Access, Suite Level Only

Gate 3 - Sections L-V, Player Guests

Gate 4 - Sections S-V, Students

Lost and Found

Lost and Found is located at Gate 2. Valuable items will be turned over to Vanderbilt's Police Department for safekeeping following the game. Contact Vanderbilt Athletics at 615-343-2012.

Wheelchair seating

Wheelchair seating is available on the south end of the stadium from Sections H through M.

Alcohol

The consumption of alcoholic beverages is prohibited.

ATMs

There are no ATMs located inside the stadium.

Cameras

No spectator cameras with lenses over six inches (6") long will be permitted.

Carry-In Items

Guests are not permitted to bring food

or beverage containers into the stadium.

Bottles, coolers and containers of any kind are prohibited.

Prohibited Items

No weapons of any kind (guns, knives, explosive devices, etc.) are permitted in Vanderbilt Stadium. Attempting to bring any weapon of any kind into the stadium will result in immediate arrest.

Re-Entry

Per Southeastern Conference rules, no re-entry is permitted at any gate. If you leave the stadium, you must have a new ticket to be admitted.

Seat Cushions

Seat cushions no larger than 16" x 16" with no pockets or backs are allowed.

Selfie Sticks

All selfie sticks are prohibited.

Strollers

Strollers are not allowed inside stadium.

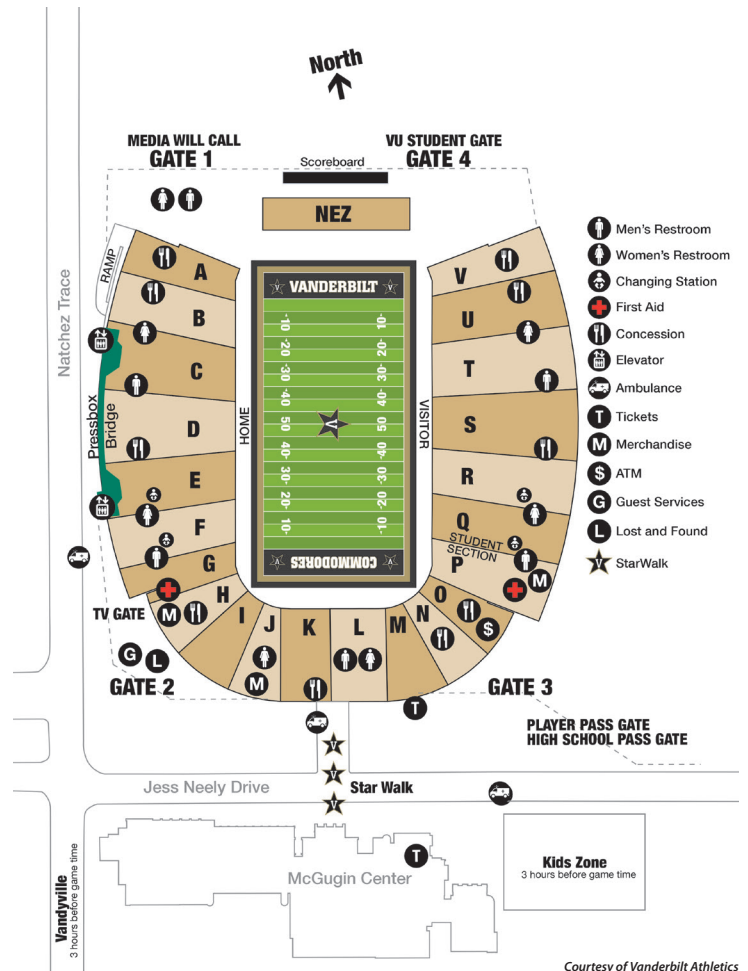
Smoking

To comply with Tennessee state law, no smoking is permitted inside Vanderbilt Stadium. This includes all areas inside the gates of the stadium including the concourses. Electronic and smokeless cigarettes are also not permitted.

Tailgating

To provide a memorable experience for all attending events within the athletic complex, the following policies are applicable:

- No common containers such as kegs
- All charcoal from charcoal grills must be disposed of properly
- Please do not encroach on another's space
- All trash must be disposed of properly
- Be considerate of others around you with loud music
- Fire pits are strictly prohibited
